 1. Sara Learn and others wanted to organize something tangible for coalition members to do right now while the planning for other things. Inspired by the executive actions and the Teach-in on Monday she will be leading an informational protest about divestment from US Bank because of it's funding of Energy Transfer Partners Inc.
