 1. Logan Neighborhood Organization is looking for 35 Gonzaga volunteers from 9-noon on Saturday, April 8 at Fourth Memorial Church, 2000 N. Standard (north parking lot).
 2. There will be 2 alternative assignments:
 - a. Unloading trucks of debris and trash neighbors bring to the drop-off
 - b. Picking up trash from disabled or elderly neighbors who cannot bring their materials to the site.
 - c. Speaker of Senate
 - i. Final three bills (CAMO, GAB Constitution, GAB By-laws) passed in the Senate Special Session last night. All official bills will be uploaded to the Senate web page ASAP!

Also collaborating with Maria Fernanda from Admissions to push for an endowment scholarship for undocumented students potentially funded by an opt-in tuition proposal (\$2.50 a semester)(Scholarship based upon a model developed by Loyola Chicago).
