A. President

C. Elections

i. Info meeting Wed and Thurs at 8 for those who wish to run

- ii. Will incorporate less senators as if bills pass and will elect more later if bills do not pass to avoid telling people they're out of a job
- iii. Moving forward with ranked choice voting because it is an election code change and requires no constitutional change

D. Attorney General

- i. Caleb vetoed 8 governance bills because in violation of proceedings because need 24 hours to read over legislation before voting and seemed rushed; senate can overrule the veto w/ 2/3 majority
- ii. Voting procedure: Go over the bill for the first time; can send back to committee or table for next week or vote on it; not everything has to be voted on in one meeting, can be saved for later
- iii. To do final vote, needs to be a final reading
- iv. Be prepared and educated voter
- v. All co-sponsors should not have more questions on it; don't need to sponsor it if they do not support it or should already have their questions answered

VII. Committee Reports

- A. Finance-funding request
 - o \$2,550 to La Raza Latina for annual festival at end of March
 - o \$595 to Alpha Kappa Psi for a professional conference
 - o \$500 to club baseball for renting a warehouse with batting cages for practice
 - o \$275 to Men's ultimate frisbee club for their PLU tournament entrance fee
 - o Matt calls to question, Murphy seconds, majority yes, request approved

B. Governance

- o On/Off Class Senators
 - Eliminates 1 on-campus senator, 1 off-campus senator, and a total of 4 class senators (one from each class)
 - To make senate more manageable and encourage increased competitiveness in election season as well as increased collaboration
 - Carlo calls to question, Matt seconds, majority in favor, bill passed
- o Lectures Chair
 - Eliminate position due to redundancy

- Matt calls to question, Sam seconds, Matt moves to make the first reading the final reading, all in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- Director of Campus Events
 - Changes GAB director to Director of Campus Event
 - coordinate NACA reservations (conference that occurs in the Spokane area)
 - Oversee Coffeehouse and Weekend Events Coordinators
 - Organize weekly meetings with coordinators and advisor
 - Liaison between coordinators and cabinet
 - Oversee GSBA Street Team
 - In charge of 1 signature event per semester, made up of fall concert and spring carnival
 - Do duties that VP deems necessary
 - Braxton moves to amend the bill to change section 6 from "Gonzaga Activities Board" to "GSBA Members"
 - Matt calls to question, Murphy seconds, majority in favor, amendment stands
 - Matt moves to make first reading final reading, Murphy seconds, majority in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- Vice President By-law
 - Updates by-laws so VP doesn't manage Gonzaga SafeRide program and Newspaper Readership Program as others do this job
 - VP supervises Class Officers
 - VP supervises and meets weekly with Cabinet Directors
 - Braxton moves to amend "Class Directors" to "Class Officers", Matt seconds, majority in favor, amendment stands
 - Matt motions to move to final reading, Murphy seconds, majority in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- GAB Office Staff Constitution Alteration
 - Changes title of "Gonzaga Activities Board" to "Office Staff"
 - Office Staff is part of Executive Branch and "Executive Staff" is currently used in constitution
 - Braxton moves to amend bill from "Office Staff" to "Executive Staff", majority in favor, amendment stands
 - Carlo motions to move to final reading, Sam seconds, majority in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- o GAB Office Staff By-Law Alteration
 - Majority in favor of changing "Office Staff" to "Executive Staff", amendment stands
 - Changes title of "Gonzaga Activities Board" to "Executive Staff"
 - Jose moves to amend bill to eliminate "Office Staff Chairpersons" from article 14, Braxton seconds, majority in favor, amendment stands
 - Carlo moves to amend article 7 from "chair the office staff" to "supervise the programmers", majority in favor, amendment stands

- Matt moves to final reading, Sam seconds, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- o Attorney Gen. By-law
 - Will no longer serve the cabinet
 - Decrease from 10 to 6 office hours a week
 - Will attend senate meetings and transcribe the minutes
 - Jose moves to make final reading, Fiona seconds, majority in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- Attorney Gen. Constitution
 - Majority in favor of discussing the bill this week
 - Attorney general appointed by GSBA president and ratified by Senate
 - Nominations will be proposed by GSBA president
 - Incidents within clubs reported to Director of Clubs and Organizations and investigation would be their responsibility
 - Jose moves to final reading, Ivana seconds, majority in favor, voting begins, majority in favor, bill passed
- o Class Officer Constitution
 - Julia motions to table till next week, Matt seconds, majority in favor, will be discussed next week
- Class Officer By-laws
 - Julia motions to table till next week, Matt seconds, majority in favor, will be discussed next week
