Title: By-Law Title & Responsibility amendments to Attorney General

Purpose: This bill outlines the by-law changes for the responsibilities of the Attorney General and reflects the changing needs this position requires.

Text:

Section 1: The responsibilities of Attorney General, as exhibited in Article XI: Section 1, to "serve on cabinet" shall be eliminated from the text.

Section 2: The hours served by the Attorney General, as exhibited in Article XI: Section 1, shall be amended to read "The Attorney General shall hold **six (6)** office hours a week."

Section 3: Article XI, Section 3, shall henceforth be eliminated from the text.

Section 4: Article XI, Section 10, shall be amended to read "The Attorney General will attend and transcribe the minutes for all weekly Senate meetings as a non-voting member to advise on Robert's Rules of Order, and ensure that all meetings run in accordance to the Constitution and By-Laws."

President	Speaker of the Senate

Section 1: The Attorney General shall be appointed by the President and take office following the ratification of the Senate. The Attorney General shall serve on cabinet, hold ten (10) office hours a week. Commented [IS1]: Hold six (6) Section 3: The Attorney General shall work with the University Judicial Affairs Officer to assist students in the University judicial process. The Attorney General, in order to advise students, should be trained and knowledgeable in the working order of the University judicial system.
