Title: Students of Logan Advisory Board

Summary: To establish the Students of Logan Advisory Board for the 2017-2018 Academic Year.

Section 1: Whereas, the Logan Coalition has collected data and feedback denoting a consistent lack of communication between off-campus students and their elected GSBA representatives.

Section 2: Whereas, the Gonzaga University Mission Statement reads, "...the Gonzaga community carries out this mission with responsible stewardship of our physical, financial and human resources."

Section 3: In the spirit of the Mission Statement, an off-campus student advisory board is necessary for the proper representation of the Gonzaga off-campus community.

Section 4: Whereas, a student advisory board will participate in the Logan Coalition meeting and Logan Neighborhood Council in effort to create a sufficient dialogue between the student body and community leaders of Logan.

Section 5: Therefore, the GSBA Senate recommends the establishment of the Students of Logan Advisory Board for the 2017-2018 Academic Year.

Section 6: Therefore, the advisory board, consisting of five (5) members of the student body that live off-campus in the Logan Neighborhood and acting Off-Campus Senator(s), would serve as the representatives of the students living in the neighborhood while attending Gonzaga University.

Section 7: Therefore, a student advisory board will work to meet bimonthly to address the off-campus environment as well as meeting monthly with the students of Logan in a public space.
