Title: Election Code Update

Purpose: To update the election code (Bylaws, article XXXIV section 3), in accordance with regulations around the new Hemmingson center

Text:

Section 1: Article XXXIV section 3, subsection D of the GSBA bylaws shall be amended to read:

“Indoor public signs may not exceed the dimensions of four feet by four feet (4x4) and may be hung on the inside railing of the Jepson Center (**this removes the words “the inside of the COG**), and inside residence halls. Tape may not be used on painted surfaces and signs may not be hung from the ceiling of the Crosby Student Center. Indoor public signs may also be hung within other buildings, upon consulting the proper building authority and gaining written approval. Building authority shall be defined as the Dean or Asst. Dean of a school. This written permission must be provided to the Commission including a signature before any material is posted in said building. E-mails shall not constitute written consent.”

Section 2: Article XXXIV, section 3, subsection H shall be amended to read: “The **Hemmingson Front Desk** must approve all public signs. Signs must include a contact person and telephone number. In the event that a concern is expressed by the **Hemmingson Front Desk** regarding an item of campaign material submitted for approval, the Commissioners may be consulted and can collaborate with **Hemmingson Front Desk** and the Candidate to make sure the concerns of both are addressed. **Hemmingson will approve fliers to be posted around bulletin boards, cork boards, etc across campus. Fliers are to be no larger than an 8.5” x 11” piece of paper. Large posters will also be approved by Hemmingson to be hung on the back staircase of college hall on a first come first served basis.**”

Section 3: A New subsection will be added to Article XXXIV section 3 of the GSBA Bylaws and it shall read: “**Nothing shall be placed on the outside of the Hemmingson center. Signs will only be allowed inside of Hemmingson center if they are submitted in a digital form to the SIL office, where they will be**

formatted, printed, and handed over the Hemmingson staff to be hung up in the area above Starbucks.”

Section 4: Article XXXIV, section 3, subsection E, shall be amended to read:
“Outdoor public signs may be of any size **(removes and may be attached to the north and west rails of the COG)**. They may also be strung across light poles, trees, etc. but must not obstruct traffic or cross over a sidewalk or street. No signs may be placed on fire escapes or on the rails of Crosby for safety reasons. The exterior of Gonzaga University owned buildings shall be an approved area only if the sign has been approved by the building authority in writing as defined in Section 4, does not obstruct the view from the inside of the building through windows, and does not impede pedestrian traffic in any manner, nor block emergency exits.”
