Title: Clarification on Resolution to Implement Airborne-Free Policy on Campus

Text:

Whereas, we recognize the vague nature of the term “airborne-free policy,”

Whereas, we recognize the need to define our intention behind the term “designated
smoking area,”

Whereas, we recognize the existing enforcement policies on airborne free products in
residence halls. Additionally, we recognize the need for further enhancement and greater
enforcement of existing airborne free policies in residence halls.

Whereas, the Health and Counseling Center will provide nicotine products that can lessen
the strain of quitting.

Therefore, we would like to define “airborne-free policy” to prohibit smoking cigarettes,
pipes, cigars, hookah, e-cigarettes, and all other applicable devices.

Therefore, a “designated smoking area” would consist of a clearly marked space with
applicable seating, cigarette receptacles, and signage highlighting education, policy
enforcement and on-campus resources.

Therefore, we recommend the greater application of floor ownership principles to
discourage a continued use of airborne products in campus residence halls. Additionally,
we recommend the higher need for education of Gonzaga residents regarding the effects
of all airborne products on users, as well as their community members in their residence
halls.

Therefore, we recognize the need for an explicitly stated enforcement policy.

Therefore, we believe that campus security and residence hall staff need to more
stringently enforce smoking policies and campus security needs to document students for
all policy violations and specifically look for smoking policy violations when patrolling
campus.
