Summary: GSBA allocates a portion of their budget to support the efforts of GSBA-sponsored clubs and organizations that contribute to the University community. There are ten months during the academic year of 2017-2018 for general clubs and sports clubs to request funds for events and resources. This bill proposes to allocate funding to clubs. Club funding total and purpose are outlined below:

Text:

Section 1: Whereas, according to the GSBA Bylaws Article XXVI Section 13B, the Senate Committee on Finance is “responsible for all financial matters pertaining to the campus as a whole”.

Section 2: Whereas, according to Article VII Section 7 of the GSBA Constitution, “All allocations and appropriations to student clubs and organizations shall first be considered by the Committee on Finance. Individual appropriations bills shall be reported on favorably or negatively by the Committee on Finance to the full Senate... All appropriations bills one-half of one percent or greater (0.5%) shall be passed using standard Senate procedure.”

Section 3: Whereas, the Committee on Finance aims to satisfy club funding requests for events and resources that benefit the Gonzaga community.

Section 4: Therefore, be it enacted that \$7,744 (Gonzaga Club Tennis (\$1075), Women’s Club Ultimate (\$440), Men’s Club Rugby (\$900), Women’s Lacrosse (\$2829), Women’s Club Soccer (\$2500)) is allocated to club sports.

1) Gonzaga Club Tennis – 1075 – Club Entry Fees and money for gas, does not exceed 50% of the costs

We will be travelling to Portland for our one big tournament of the fall. We will take three teams of 8 people each to the tournament, and it is usually the highlight of many people's fall semester because it is the only time that we all get to travel together. We are requesting \$1075 for the weekend. The tournament entry fees total \$675 and the other \$400 request is for gas. This gas estimate comes from how much we spent on gas to drive to this tournament last year. Club Tennis has received generous funding from GSBA in the past, and it is truly awesome being able to experience tournaments like this with their help.

2) Women's Club Ultimate – 440 for Hotels for Big Sky Tournament

This request supports our travel for the first tournament of the year to Missoula Montana. We will play for the first time as a team together in a competitive environment. Part of traveling is the hotel expense that can add up and this would be a huge help for the development of our team.

3) Men's Club Rugby – 900 – Hotel Rooms for NCRC Men's Rugby tournament

Our objective is to win the NCRC tournament in order to possibly qualify for the televised national 7s tournament. We hope to strengthen the program, intensify our level of rugby, and provide an unforgettable experience for team members who will participate in this competitive tournament.

4) Women's Lacrosse – 2829 – Uniforms

Our spring season is 4 months away and we are in desperate need of new uniforms. Our current uniforms are stained, letters and numbers are peeling off of our jerseys, and the blue of our skirts does not match the blue in our away jerseys. If the request were to be completed it would pay for 20 home jerseys, 20 away jerseys, 20 skirts, and 2 goalie uniform sets.

5) Women's Club Soccer – 2500 – Regional Tournament in Boise – 2000 for hotels and 500 for gas

This year we are trying to go to our Regional Soccer Tournament located in Boise, ID from Oct. 27th-29th. Last year we went to the tournament destined to test our skill as we do not have much competition here in the Northwest. We placed 1st in the tournament and made a name for Gonzaga University, then continued on to play in the National Tournament in Alabama. None of the tournament directors expected a small school team to even win a game and we managed to upset many teams. Here in the Northwest we usually dominate our league winning around 5-0 per game. This tournament is our chance to keep testing our skill and ability in a competitive setting.
