Summary: GSBA allocates a portion of their budget to support the efforts of GSBA-sponsored clubs and organizations that contribute to the University community. There are ten months during the academic year of 2017-2018 for general clubs and sports clubs to request funds for events and resources. This bill proposes to allocate funding to clubs. Club funding total and purpose are outlined below:

Text:

Section 1: Whereas, according to the GSBA Bylaws Article XXVI Section 13B, the Senate Committee on Finance is “responsible for all financial matters pertaining to the campus as a whole”.

Section 2: Whereas, according to Article VII Section 7 of the GSBA Constitution, “All allocations and appropriations to student clubs and organizations shall first be considered by the Committee on Finance. Individual appropriations bills shall be reported on favorably or negatively by the Committee on Finance to the full Senate... All appropriations bills one-half of one percent or greater (0.5%) shall be passed using standard Senate procedure.”

Section 3: Whereas, the Committee on Finance aims to satisfy club funding requests for events and resources that benefit the Gonzaga community.

Section 4: Therefore, be it enacted that \$4,632 (Women’s Club Soccer) is allocated to general club sports/national’s fund and that \$3,000 (Ski and Snowboard Club) is allocated to general clubs.

1. Women's Club Soccer (\$4,632), \$3,000 out of National's Fund and \$1,632 out of general club sports

The funding request we are asking for is for hotels, rental cars and gas, tournament fee and flights for Women's Club Soccer's participation in the National Tournament in Phoenix, Arizona. The tournament will take place from Nov. 16th to the 18th. The team will travel to Phoenix on the 15th of November and return on the 19th. This tournament is a great opportunity for the team to represent our school in other areas of the country.

2. Ski and Snowboard Club, \$3,000

Gonzaga Ski and Snowboard Club is requesting \$3,000 to help pay for the lodging and lift tickets on the five trips that takes its members to various mountain resorts. The Ski and Snowboard Club at Gonzaga helps create a community for ski and snowboard enthusiasts. This funding will help make these trips more affordable for our 300+ club members and give more members the opportunity to ski and board these mountain resorts.
